First of all, we would like to thank you for submitting your abstract and congratulate you on your acceptance to the forthcoming Sardinia 2015 - Fifteenth International Waste Management and Landfill Symposium, which promises to be an exceptionally successful edition of the Sardinia Symposia.

Abstracts were selected following a careful process carried out by world leading waste management experts, according to their scientific quality, innovation and relevance of the subject.

Final destination (Oral, Poster or Workshop) was established according to the following criteria: request by the author, topic relevance, characteristics of the paper (highly specific, preliminary results, case study) and number of papers received on the same topic.

REGISTRATION OF PRESENTERS

Following notification of abstract acceptance, a presenting author must be appointed among the authors of the paper.

In order to secure their place in the conference programme, presenting authors must register and pay their registration fee to the Symposium within 20 days of their notification of acceptance by filling in the form available on the official Symposium website at:

Stringent criteria were applied in the abstract selection and a waiting list has been drawn up; therefore, registration must be completed strictly by the allotted deadline. Failure to provide with this requirement may imply removal of a paper from the Symposium Programme.

Please note that only one presenting author can be appointed for each paper.

However, each presenting author may deliver up to three presentations during the conference.

Terms and conditions, as well as detailed information about registration fees, are outlined on the official Symposium website.

FULL PAPERS SUBMISSION

Presenting authors (including those scheduled for poster presentation) will be requested to provide the following documents no later than May 20th:

- A one-page summary and a full paper, typed and edited strictly in accordance with the instructions to authors available on the Symposium website
- A short Curriculum Vitae (maximum 1000 characters)

- A signed copy of the Copyright assignment form

Final papers must reflect the contents of the abstract originally submitted.

Proper English must be used. If necessary, the paper should be checked by a native English speaker with expertise in the field.

Authors presenting their work in an oral session or workshop will also be requested to submit their PowerPoint presentations no later than 25th September 2015.

All final papers accepted to Sardinia 2015 will be published on a dedicated ISSN, ISBN volume and will be submitted to Scopus for indexing.

Additionally, a number of leading papers selected by the Symposium Scientific Committee will be processed for publication on special thematic issues of Waste Management, the scientific journal with the highest IF (3.157) in the field, published by Elsevier.

Authors wishing to publish their paper on WM journal are invited to carefully read the Guide for Authors available on the journal website at <http://www.elsevier.com/journals/waste-management/0956-053X/guide-for-authors>, in order to prepare a paper that matches the standards of the journal. The selection for the Peer Review process will take place immediately after the deadline for papers submission (20th May), which therefore must be strictly observed.
